(Anchorage, Alaska) On August 27, 2012, Anchorage resident Randy Hahn, 51 years old, was convicted in Anchorage Superior Court of one count of Attempted Failure to Pay Vehicle Rental Tax, a Class A misdemeanor, and his solely held corporation, Kiska Corporation, was convicted of one count of Failure to Pay Vehicle Rental Tax, a Class C felony.

As part of his plea agreement, Randy Hahn was sentenced to serve six months in jail and will be on probation for 10 years. Kiska Corporation and Randy Hahn must pay full restitution of more than \$600,000 for unpaid vehicle rental taxes for the years 2004-2008.

The convictions are the result of a lengthy investigation conducted by the Alaska Department of Revenue's Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU). The CIU is tasked with the responsibility of conducting statewide investigations of criminal and civil violations of Alaska statutes and regulations for the Tax Division, Permanent Fund Division, and Child Support Services Division.
